- Organization must be incorporated as a non-profit society (In good standing with Registry of Joint Stock or sponsored by an organization that is registered).
- Eligible items: plants, soil, fertilizer, gravel, fencing, paint, planters, etc.
- Ineligible items: gasoline, motorized equipment

Application:

- Provide a summary of your current enhancement plans for your community as well as incorporate long-term plans.
- Provide a breakdown of your proposed expenses.
- Date and sign application form and return by email, fax, or Canada Post.
- Staff will follow up with you by phone or email regarding your application.

When Project is Complete:

- Submit photocopies of receipts/proof of purchase for reimbursement.
- Provide a project summary report.
- Email photos of completed project
