

MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF INVERNESS

COUNCIL POLICY

SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY: Municipal Government Act
Section 65(f)(aa)(aaa)

PREAMBLE: Section 65 (f)(aa)(aaa) of the Municipal Government Act provides the authority for the municipality to construct and provide maintenance of sidewalks in the Municipality of the County of Inverness.

TERMS: It shall be the policy of the Municipal Council of the Municipality of the County of Inverness that the Municipality will provide maintenance of sidewalks constructed under an agreement with the Department of Transportation.

It shall be the policy of the Municipality of the County of Inverness to provide ice and snow control at a reasonable level of service for a reasonable and affordable cost. Efforts will be made to maintain sidewalks for comfortable and safe walking. Plowing, sanding, and salting will normally be done between the hours of 4:30 p.m. and 7 a.m., Monday to Friday.

The Municipality does not take responsibility for removing snow from private driveways nor any entrance or doorway.

It shall be the policy of the Municipality of the County of Inverness that the Municipality shall provide as follows:

- (1) Snow removal from sidewalks within three days of a storm event.
- (2) Salting and/or sanding of sidewalks as required.
- (3) No later than May 31st of each calendar year, carry out an annual inspection of sidewalks.
