

MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF INVERNESS

Documents Required for Record of Convictions Against Applicant for Taxi Driver's License Application

As part of the Taxi Driver's License Application, the Applicant is required to provide the Municipality of the County of Inverness with a record of convictions against the Applicant. To meet this requirement, the Municipality of the County of Inverness requires the Applicant to submit the following three (3) documents along with their Application:

- 1. **Criminal Record Check with a Vulnerable Sector Check** (dated within 30 days of the date of the Taxi Driver's License Application);
- Driver's Abstract (dated within 30 days of the date of the Taxi Driver's License Application); and
- 3. **Child Abuse Registry Check** (dated within 30 days of the date of the Taxi Driver's License Application).

The Applicant is solely responsible to pay any fees required to obtain the above-noted documents.

HOW TO OBTAIN THESE DOCUMENTS

1. Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Check

To obtain a Criminal Record Check with a Vulnerable Sector Check, you must contact an RCMP Detachment in the Inverness County District and follow all directions provided. Contact information for these detachments is provided below:

3. Child Abuse Registry Check

To obtain a Child Abuse Registry Check from the Nova Scotia Department of Community Services, you must submit a Child Abuse Register Request for Search (Form A) to the Nova Scotia Department of Community Services.
