Medical Waste

Medical waste should be placed in a yellow container provided by your local pharmacy for syringes, needles and unused or outdated medicines.

For the safety of municipal staff, please do not place syringes or needles in pop or laundry detergent bottles. The yellow containers can be returned to the pharmacy for disposal. Continued infractions will result in discontinuation of services.

Household Hazardous Waste

This waste is collected at an annual event in the fall. This includes compact fluorescent bulbs, pesticides, varnish, etc.

Full or Partially Used Paint

Paint cans containing paint go back to the Enviro Depot anytime. Empty paint cans go to regular garbage.

Electronics

Televisions, monitors, computers, telephones, audio visual equipment, printers & cell phones can be returned to the Municipal Recycling Facility at 15109 Highway 19, Strathlorne.
