

PROCLAMATION

Whereas: Over 100,000 children from toddlers to the age of eighteen were emigrated from

all areas of the UK to Canada. These children were either adopted or used as a source of labour on our farms and in our Canadian households. They are known

today as 'British Home Children' (BHC); and

Whereas: There is an estimated four million descendants of BHC living in Canada today;

and

Whereas: Many of these children settled on Cape Breton Island and the province of Nova

Scotia. They contributed enormously to the building of the Island; and

Whereas: The year 2019 marks the arrival of the first party of BHC to Canada; and

Whereas: On September 28th, our National British Home Children Day in Canada, cities and

municipalities across Canada as well as England and Scotland participated in the 'Beacons of Light for the BHC and Child Migrants Tribute' to honours the memory

of the BHC and their descendants.

Therefore: I, Betty Ann MacQuarrie, Warden of the Municipality of the County of Inverness,

do hereby proclaim September 28th to be known as British Home Child Day in the

Municipality of the County of Inverness.
