# MUNICIPAL FLOOD LINE MAPPING: EVA MOOERS

Eva Mooers is a water resource engineer with the Department of Municipal Affairs. She spoke about the Municipal Flood Line Mapping Project. The purpose of this project is to remove barriers for municipalities in the creation of up to date flood mapping through the development of Provincial Specifications and Guidance. The province intends to hire a consultant to prepare a flood hazard mapping study for the Margaree area. The province will conduct the RFP process and evaluate proposals and finance the study. The Municipality is welcome to participate in this process and evaluate submissions. *Presentation attached to the minutes* 

### DEPARTMENT OF MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS - ROSS MACDONALD

Ross MacDonald is on the Municipal Advisory team with the Department of Municipal Affairs. He spoke on his past roles with the Province of Nova Scotia. He is looking forward to working with the Municipality, facing challenges, finding resources, and bringing concerns forward. Council mentioned key concerns such as infrastructure and roads.

### BEFORE AND AFTER CARE PROGRAM - DONNA MACDONALD AND MELANIE BEATON

Donna MacDonald and Melanie Beaton spoke on the Before and After Care Program. Representatives from the Department of Communities, Cultures and Heritage (CCH) approached Municipal staff in late July to assess interest and capacity to become a Before and After Program (BAP) delivery partner. The Municipality was asked if there is interest in administrating this program. Concern was raised among Council that communities and Municipal staff are being downloaded with this task. Consensus was reached to have additional discussion with staff on this item.
