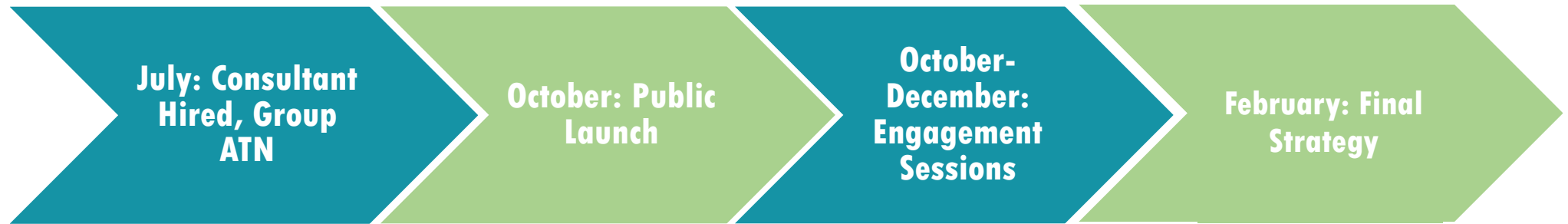
# Why?
