# INITIATIVE UPDATE

May 7, 2020

The Municipality continues to support the SchoolsPlus Youth Hamper Program. SchoolsPlus is a collaborative interagency approach supporting the whole child and their family with the school as the center of service delivery. SchoolsPlus staff act as liaisons between the school and community and advocate, coordinate, and expand services for students and families. They help families navigate the system and get the services they need.

On Wednesday April 29, 2020, Municipal staff in partnership with SchoolsPlus and Strait Area Transit organized the second delivery of 130 Emergency Food hampers to students throughout the County.



- The Pandemic Response Team continues to partner, communicate and work with Fire Halls , Food Bank staff and Meals on Wheels programs.
- The Hamper Program is scheduled to occur every two weeks as long as funding allows.
- The Helpline continues to be monitored by Municipal staff.
