

BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the Municipality of the County of Inverness that By-law No. 15, Tax on Commencing Business, be repealed and re-enacted as follow:

BY-LAW 14

TAX ON COMMENCING BUSINESS


1. All persons who commence to occupy premises in the Municipality for the purpose of carrying on business, or who commence in the Municipality any business of any kind, at any time after the first day of April in any year shall pay to the municipal treasurer the sum of fifty (\$50) dollars before commencing business as aforesaid, except those:
 - (a) Who for the calendar year immediately preceding such date have been assessed for real property or business occupancy, within the Municipality; or
 - (b) Who have within that period paid rates to the Municipality in respect of property in the Municipality.
2. Every Person who violates the provisions of this By-Law shall on conviction be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred (\$100) dollars and in default of payment of imprisonment for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.


