1. WATER METER REPLACEMENT UPDATE

Inefficiencies with the water billings led to the water meter replacement and upgrade project in 2019. This project saw the Municipality retrofit usable water meters and upgrade others with the new Neptune meters. Over 1500 meters were upgraded with the new Neptune meters. Some are still awaiting the upgrade. Overall, the Municipality's water utility revenues have increased since this project began. The remainder of the water meter replacement project will cost \$28,000.00.
