#### 2. KAMLOOPS (TK'EMLUPS) RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL

The National Flag outside the Port Hood Administration Building has been lowered to honour the memory of 215 children whose remains were discovered at the site of the former Kamloops Residential School. A statement on behalf of Council will be posted, and a letter will be issued to Cape Breton First Nations Communities regarding this issue. Municipal staff will plan educational sessions with First Nations to educate ourselves and better understand the issues faced by First Nations.

### 3. 2021 – 2022 WATER UTILITY OPERATIONS BUDGET
