## 5. PROVINCIAL GRANT RESOLUTIONS

**MOTION:** Following review of the completed project description, the Council of the

Municipality of the County of Inverness moves that the following application is rated and recommended first (1st) priority for application to

the Provincial Capital Assistance Program (PCAP).

1st Priority: Municipal Infrastructure Realignment, Port Hastings Rotary

The Nova Scotia Department of Public Works (NSDPW) plans to re-design the Port Hastings Rotary. There were no plans for Municipal water and sanitary sewer replacement in Port Hastings however a re-alignment is now required due to the changes proposed by NSDPW. Although the Municipal work was unplanned, it provides the Municipality with the opportunity to minimize infrastructure renewal costs by coordinating subsurface utility work and roadworks. This will eliminate resurfacing costs, reduce reinstatement costs, and eliminate near-future disturbances to the roadway from Municipal pipe breaks and emergency repairs. The Port Hastings water and sanitary sewer re-alignment and replacement work will address infrastructure condition, ensure the ease of future unplanned maintenance, and will protect the integrity of NSPW's infrastructure by re-locating as much Municipal subsurface utilities, as is possible, from underneath the province's transportation infrastructure.

Total Project Costs (net HST): \$2,890,954.00 Provincial Contribution: \$1,445,477.00 Ultimate Recipient Cost: \$1,445,477.00
