

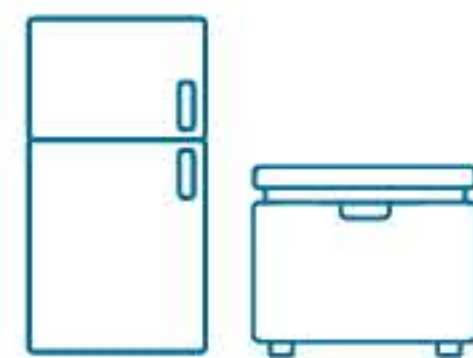
Residential Spring Bulky Garbage Collection

The Municipality of Inverness County is offering residential spring bulky garbage collection, providing households the chance to dispose of items too big for regular curbside collection. Materials can be placed curbside and left for the duration of the collection week.

✓ MATERIALS ACCEPTED FOR PICK-UP

LARGE APPLIANCES

Weighing 75 lbs or less; maximum of two appliances per household – please remove doors if possible



FURNITURE

Mattresses, couches and chairs (must be covered)



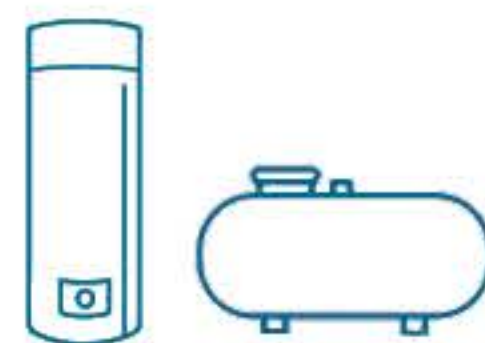
CARPET

Must be rolled in 4-foot lengths



OTHER HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Boilers, empty water tanks, oil tanks (empty and dry) and BBQs (propane removed)



WOOD ITEMS

Including dressers, furniture, chairs, desks, shelving and tables (items must be disassembled and drawers removed when possible)



✗ MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIALS

Siding, windows, doors, gyprock, shingles, etc.



RECYCLABLES

Cardboard or recyclable materials (anything that belongs in your blue recycling bags)



ELECTRONICS

Television, computers and other electronics



OTHER WASTE

Clothing, leaf or yard waste, fishing ropes, nets and traps



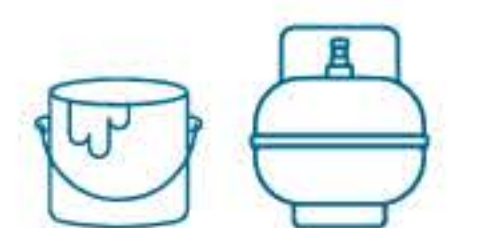
AUTOMOBILE ITEMS

Vehicle tires (to be returned to tire retailer) or automobile parts



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Paint, batteries, propane and oil



! IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Regularly scheduled garbage pick up will continue throughout the bulky garbage collection week
- Regular garbage (items that can fit in a standard garbage bag) will not be picked up during bulky garbage collection
- 20-item limit per household
- Items longer than 4 feet must be broken down
- Keep items within 10 feet from the road for easy access
- Roads are visited once during the collection period
- Separate your regular household garbage and recycling from your bulky items
- Items in trailers or trucks will not be collected
- Collectors are not responsible for cleaning up debris after pickup
- Residents must remove non-accepted items after collection
- Do not place important items near your bulky garbage pile – items mistakenly taken are not the municipality's responsibility

♻️ ALTERNATIVE DISPOSAL LOCATIONS

Kenloch Waste Management Facility:

Accepts paint, oil, construction/demolition materials, automobile tires, clothing, leaf or yard waste, fishing rope, netting and traps

Strathlorne Municipal Recycling Facility:

Accepts electronics, batteries, light bulbs (including CFLs) and textiles (Diabetes Canada bin)

Residential Household Hazardous Waste Events:

The municipality hosts household hazardous waste collection events on a regular basis in partnership with a third-party organization. These events give residents an opportunity to safely dispose of household hazardous waste like chemicals, propane cylinders, fire extinguishers, and more.
